#### A new creation

We continue to follow Jesus on the road from Galilee to Jerusalem where, he knows, he will be handed over to his persecutors and be put to death on the cross. Jesus pauses along the way. The deepest stirrings of the spirit can surface when we rest. In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks of the conflict of emotions within his soul. Side-by-side within him he experiences the burning desire to go forward and the distressing prospect of the sea of suffering into which he must plunge. Luke writes for a community which will know that same inner conflict.



The Gospel contains two sayings about the nature of Jesus' mission. His coming marks a time for making decisions.

mission. His coming marks a time for making decisions. His followers will have to make crucial choices; they will have to choose to be for him or against him. Choosing him may divide them from family members. In the early Church, conversion was likely to cause a family row. The convert was rejected by the family and had therefore to make a choice between Christ and the family.

Christians should not be surprised if the Gospel divides people. Jesus' sense of justice brought him into conflict with those who exploited the weak and the poor. His integrity brought him into conflict with the narrow-minded and the bigoted. The brighter the light, the darker the shadow it casts.

Jesus says he came to kindle a fire upon the earth. Fire burns up what is of no use and refines what is impure.

Lord we ask for a deeper sense of peace within our own lives, with each other and with you.


